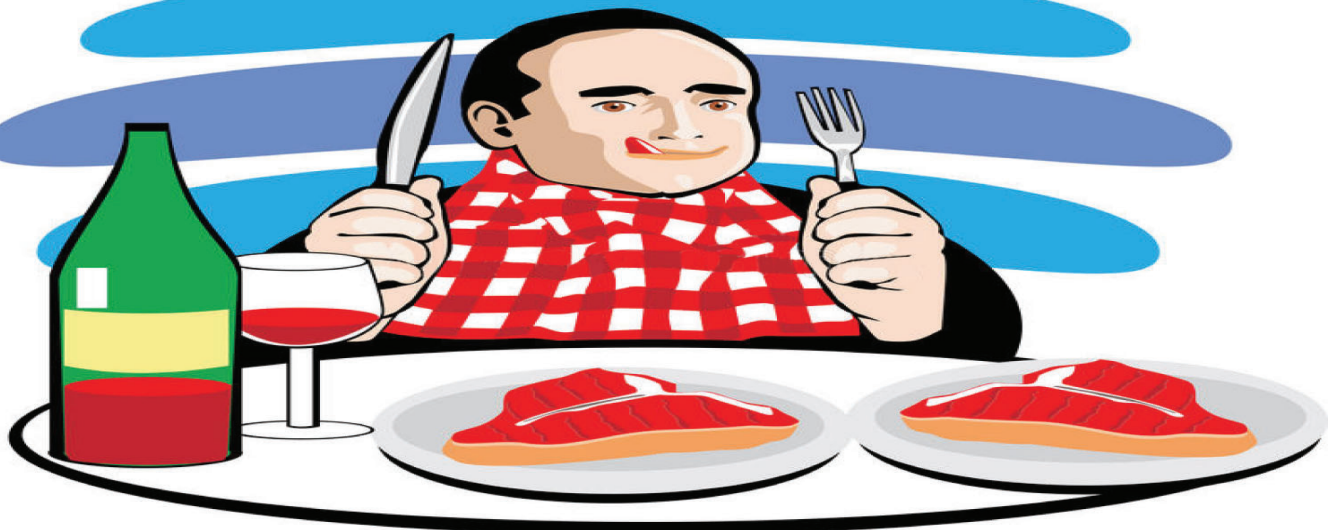

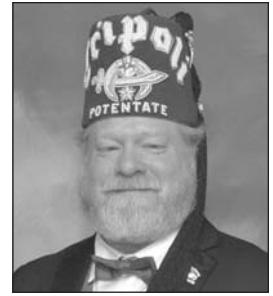

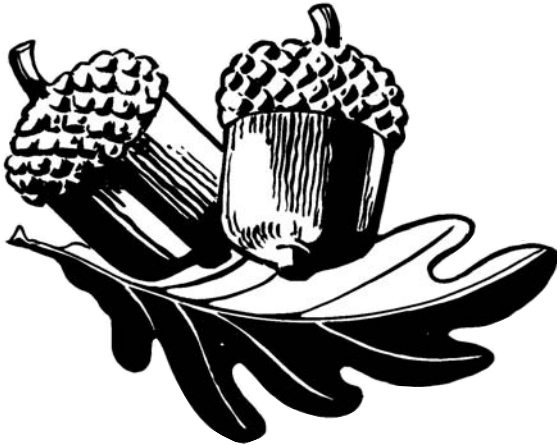

Web Fez will be offering an on-line dues payment feature in the near future. We will also look into n-line dues payment attached to our web site. We are working to up-grade our phone system.

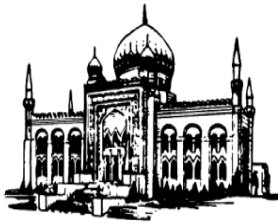
