"When she was born, we knew right away she had a special purpose," Barb said. Right away, Felt had a vision for Marvel's future. "We wanted her to go in a home with someone who had a limb difference," Barb said. She was soon connected to the Williams family in Waconia by another one of her clients, who is the occupational therapist for 7-year-old Paxton Williams. He was born extremely premature, and developed an infection in his leg that stunted its growth.

developed an infection in his leg that stunted its growth. Three years ago, his parents made the decision to have doctors amputate his foot and give him a prosthetic so he could more easily walk and move around on his own.

Barb knew Paxton would be the perfect match for Marvel. Blaine Williams, Paxton's father, says he and his wife Stephanie love to see their son and Marvel overcome their limb differences together. "It's like they knew they were special," Blaine said. In just a week of bringing Marvel home, Paxton has already taken her on a lot of walks along the trails near their home.

Know Your Noble Nobel Paul E Peterson PP 1997 By Ceil Klein

"Family, Fraternity and Church" Paul Peterson P.P. and his wife, Betty (Tischer) live in a quite subdivision in New Berlin where they are anxiously awaiting the covid restrictions to be over because family is the most important thing in their lives. We all could say that, but in this Sicilian, Italian family, it means just about 50 immediate family members. Betty from a previous marriage of 32 years, her husband passing away from cancer, had four children. Now after 42 years of marriage with Paul they have 10 grandchildren, 19 great grandchildren and 2 great-great grandchildren, plus 3 on the way.

At Betty's 90th birthday party, celebrated at Tripoli Shrine, there were 100 from her side alone. Paul's 90th will be in 2026 and that will be a party to remember. Betty grew up in the neighborhood surrounding the Shrine and remembers peeking into the windows of the Mosque thinking how grand it looked. She reminisces about riding the camels for fun. Little did she know that in 1997 she would be the First Lady, alongside Paul as Potentate.

Raised a Master Mason in 1964 at Wauwatosa Lodge 267, Paul then joined the Scottish Rite, Valley of Milwaukee in 1976 and 10 years later he became a member of the Tripoli Shriners. A member of the Ritualistic Divan, member of both the Waukesha and Racine Shrine Clubs. Paul has also been a Royal Masons Kilbourn-Calumet Chapter #1, Knight Templar Wisconsin Commander #1, St Wilfred Conclave, Red Cross of Constantine, Order of Quetzalcoatl, Teocalli #50, Eastern Star, West Allis Chapter #172, and Red Fez. He has been active on numerous financial committees and fundraiser events, acting as chairman on several. All this was when he became Potentate in 1997. Since then, he has been an instrumental resource and supporter of the Shrine and its members. He has been guoted as "a person who represents dignity and patriotism for our country".

After all his illustrious titles and dedication, what I found more intriguing is that Paul's job as an appraiser took him all around the world, and he never missed a Stated Meeting at Tripoli.



Stated meetings, Lodges, Units, fundraisers and more, he never missed an event. Dinners, installations, or balls were never pushed aside.

When he was away, he gained immense satisfaction in attending whatever function Shriners or Lodges would have on their calendar, in the towns he traveled to. Philadelphia, Houston, London, and Hong Kong to name a few.

When he was in Pago Pago, American Samoa, he searched for a lodge and eventually found one, the size of a two-car garage. They called around and found the Master of the lodge to let him in.

When attending many events in Norfolk, Virginia, where he frequented, there was a joke going around that they wanted to "put him on the line."

From the Tattler 1997: "His responsibilities took him as far west of Singapore, as far North as 600 miles south of Antarctic Circle, as far South as 13,000 feet up the mountains of Peru" and "he can apply his wealth of experience to lead Tripoli along new paths to greater success." The year of 1997 was a profitable year. "You get out of it, what you put into it" was his saying. Paul was Potentate at the time when Tripoli just finished a full restoration project, which had taken years, to get the Mosque back to its original state. He told me that years before, they painted the walls brown so that smoke from cigars and cigarettes did not show. The only way to describe it is 'dirty and dingy.' "For years we kept it to ourselves, then it was time to open it up to the public". What a wonderful building to share with Milwaukee. Paul and Betty's grandson, JJ, got married there.

Paul accomplished so much being in Masonry for almost 60 years, but the one thing he is best known for, is his complete knowledge of the Mosque. Paul was asked to come down for all scheduled tours to narrate them, taking visitors through a historical glimpse of time, as if the Mosque could talk. That prompted him to start on his next project. He took it upon himself to consolidated many articles and added his own knowledge to make the *Tripoli Shrine Center* tour booklet that stands today, for all who want to take a self-guided tour. Room by Room it tells you the 'when and how' and describes all the reasons behind the names of the rooms, additions, and remodelling, including the reason that staircase goes nowhere.

Paul still attends many functions, but due to Betty's health, their greatest place to be is home with family. Memories fill their home with two large pictures of them as Sir III Paul Petersen, and his beautiful Lady Betty, taken at Tripoli and numerous portraits of family. At the end of our visit, Paul gave a little chuckle when saying, "I am third in line right now, there's George Vignyvich, Bob Manske and me, 1991, 1995, and I am in third, 1997 for Past Potentates still living". Now at 84 years young, this tough Sargent of the Marine Corps gets led around by his finger, by the smallest of great-great-grandchildren, to explore and make new memories.

"The amount of emotions that were running through me at the time, it was just awesome because it was knowing that she was in the perfect place at the perfect time," Blaine said.

Stephanie has already seen Marvel make a difference in the way Paxton shares his own story with his friends and neighbors.

"It gives him the opportunity to tell the kids, 'Oh she's missing a paw, she's like me,' and like it gives him that voice, too, to advocate for himself," Stephanie said.

As Marvel gets older, she may need a wheelchair or prosthetic of her own to get around. For now, the hope is someday Paxton will be able to run with his prosthetic, and Marvel will be able to run alongside him.
