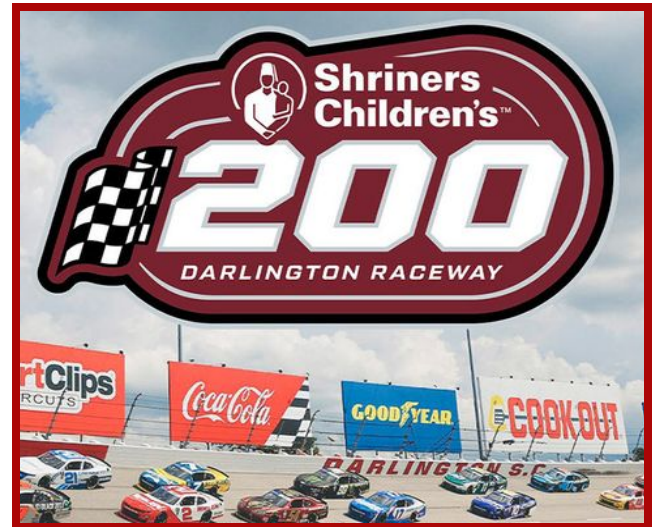

"After she's done with the scalpal, surgeon makes art on kids' casts"

Wesley Puttrich was born with two thumbs on his right hand, limiting his hand movement. The 2-year-old had surgery for the condition, called preaxial polydactyly or bifid thumb, at Shriners Children's Chicago hospital this year.

When he woke up, he was staring at something his pediatric orthopedic surgeon, Felicity Fishman, had left for him: A bright green and yellow tyrannosaurus rex. Fishman had drawn the dinosaur on his cast immediately after the surgery. He kept the cast on for about four weeks, and he loved his T. rex so much that he cried when it was time to cut it off

last month. "He wanted to keep the dinosaur with him, so we decided to save the cast, and it's now in his room where Wesley can look at it whenever he wants," said his mother, Katie Puttrich, who lives in Crest Hill, Ill. To Fishman, that is the ultimate compliment.

"If they can look at my drawing and remember a positive experience, that's wonderful to me," she said. "Anything you can do to connect with a child during the course of a surgery is helpful in maintaining that relationship."

Fishman's best work — repaired joints, placing prosthetic bones and carefully inserting metal plates — can't be seen with the naked eye, but she said she decided nearly three years ago to start making something fun for her young patients to wake up to after their operations. "No matter how beautiful of a surgery you do, all the family is looking at for several weeks is the cast," said Fishman, 43. "I thought it would be nice to turn it into something more positive for everyone to look at." Fishman, who specializes in pediatric hand and arm surgery, initially decorated casts with colorful striped tape or glitter glue, she said. Then a doctor in training suggested that she try to find some colored pens with weatherproof ink. "We found some pens [online] that could be used on anything, even rocks," she said. "If they would hold up on a rock, I figured they would also hold up on a cast."

2024 Proposed Tripoli Dues Increase

A motion was made and seconded for a Tripoli dues increase in 2024, 2025, & 2026. This would be a \$10.00 increase in 2024, a \$5.00 increase in 2025, followed by a \$5.00 increase in 2026. The \$10.00 miscellaneous fee would be dropped.

The last dues increase was in 2010. Dues were \$50 for core counties and \$29 for out of core counties. They were increased for the core counties by \$20 in 2011, and \$10 in 2012, & 2013. The same was passed for out of core counties but evidently never implemented beyond 2011. The current Tripoli dues are \$90 for core counties and \$49 for out of core counties. If the proposed increase is passed the Tripoli dues will be as followings starting in 2024:

The procedure to pass this increase is:

- 1) Present the motion at a stated meeting (March 8, 2023) and lay over until next stated meeting.
- 2) Send information to membership via Tattler, Email, and Regular mails as necessary.
- 3) Act on the motion at next stated meeting (April 12, 2023) and take vote of members present. A 2/3 majority is required to pass.

The following motion was presented and seconded at the March 8, 2023 Stated Meeting. A discussion followed and the motion was laid over until the April 12, 2023, meeting.

Resolution for Dues Increase March 8, 2023

WHEREAS, Tripoli Shriners, Inc. (Tripoli) invoices members for dues on an annual basis.
 WHEREAS the Tripoli budget is largely driven by timely receipt of dues.
 WHEREAS Tripoli desires to increase dues across all membership categories as stated in the Tripoli Policy Manual by \$10.00 for the year 2024.
 WHEREAS Tripoli desires to increase dues across all membership categories as stated in the Tripoli Policy Manual by \$5.00 for the year 2025 and 2026.
 WHEREAS, The Tripoli Board of Directors has voted in favor of this resolution, and it has been favorably reviewed by the Finance Committee.
 WHEREAS' this resolution is in compliance with current Bylaws of Tripoli Shriners and the new dues fees will be contained in the Tripoli Policy Manual.
 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tripoli Shriners, Inc. will raise its annual membership dues by \$10.00 across all membership categories, effective for the calendar year 2024 as well as \$5.00 per year in 2025 and 2026 in which dues are payable.
