Here are the guidelines that need to be followed:

1. You need to get all **flyers approved by the Potentate, according to the national by-laws.**
2. If you want to have your flyer in the Tattler, it needs to be submitted to me 30 days prior, no later than the first of the month you want it to run in. **30 days before the run date.**
3. If you need it designed, please notify me by the 15th of the month prior. **45 days before the run date.**
4. The information that is needed:
 - Event Location along with address
 - Date and Time
 - Menu (if there is one)
 - Price (include PayPal?)
 - Event Contacts with information
 - Event Beneficiary (per Shriners Intl, should not be Shriner's Children)
 - If it is open to the public, it needs to state that.
5. Pictures need to be sent individually to my email
6. I will Keep in touch with drafts of the flyer.
7. Keep in mind that after the flyer is done, further work needs to be completed:
 - Didgital marketing needs to be creating
 - Information for the website and email blasts
 - Facebook posts are created with the flyer.

All this takes a considerable amount of time and I am a volunteer team of one. Please try to get your information from all sources early enough to keep on this timeline.
