
Stated Meeting is May 10th - be sure to make your reservations for dinner.



### **Meet Bethany Deines Director of Philanthropy** Shriners Children's Ohio

At our last Stated Meeting Beth gave a fantastic presentation on the Shriners Children's Ohio Burn Center and also rallied for all treatments in the world that we have accomplished, complete with pictures, statistics and videos to explain the wonderful treatments and advances in Burn care and Craniofacial Anomalies. She was also diligent about bringing the facts on burn prevention.

Bethany shared some amazing stories that captivated Bio: Bethany is responsible for the strategic initiatives for our shrine center, receiving a standing ovation and hopefully some checks. Although our locations are primarily in North America, our compassionate healthcare system has treated children from many countries, and conducts several medical outreach clinics outside of the U.S. every year.

a Raquel was born with a hole in the middle of her face so big she could put her fist inside it. It's a rare birth defect called facial bipartition. "If I were to compare her to the usual clefts I see, on a scale of zero to ten, she is the ten," says Petra Warner, MD, chief of staff at Shriner's Hospital for Children -Cincinnati.

Hilcy got Raguel to a Cincinnati Shriner's clinic in Guatemala City. A doctor there knew Chris Gordon, MD, craniofacial surgeon did this kind of work when asked he took her case.

Raquel's surgery was intense, requiring substantial resources. Dr. Gordon brought in Robert Lober, MD, PhD, a neurosurgeon at Dayton Children's to be his partner, along with an entire team of surgical and critical care staff.



### Jeffery and Adam



Adam, Jeffery's dad, was cleaning up the yard and burning brush when Jeffrey knocked over the can of fuel. The fumes from the gas can catch fire, burning Jeffrey, then just 2 years old, on nearly 50% of his body. Adam immediately grabbed his son and smothered the flames, burning his own hands in the process. A neighbor called 911 and little Jeffrey was flown to a hospital in Kansas City, where he was then transferred to Shriners Children's Ohio.


Jeffery and Adam continued

Adam's journey to becoming a Shriner really began almost a decade ago after that tragic accident at their home.



The month of May is here and so are some special days. May 8th is VE Day or Victory in Europe Day, ending the fighting in Europe in World War Two. Next is May 14th, Mother's Day. That special day for your mother or the mother of your children. DeMolay has a public ceremony called the Flower Talk which is dedicated to our mothers.

If your mother is living, take a red flower, give it to her and tell her it is our recognition of God's best gift to a man, his mother's love". Finally, there is Memorial Day, May 29th. While many think this is the unofficial day to summer, it should be remembered for what it means. It is to honor people such as Senior DeMolay and Medal of Honor recipient, Lance Sijan who died while a prisoner of war in Viet Nam, or Harvey Hansen whose name is on a marble wall along with 1176 other men on the USS Arizona Memorial or Cheryl LaBeau-O'Brien who was killed in Desert Storm when the helicopter she was on was shot down while on a rescue mission. ### Notes From the Recorder

A motion was made and seconded for a Tripoli dues increase in 2024, 2025, & 2026. This would be a \$10.00 increase in 2024, a \$5.00 increase in 2025, followed by a \$5.00 increase in 2026. The \$10.00 miscellaneous fee would be dropped completely. The motion required a 2/3 majority and passed at the April Stated Meeting. Our current and future dues schedule will be as follows:


