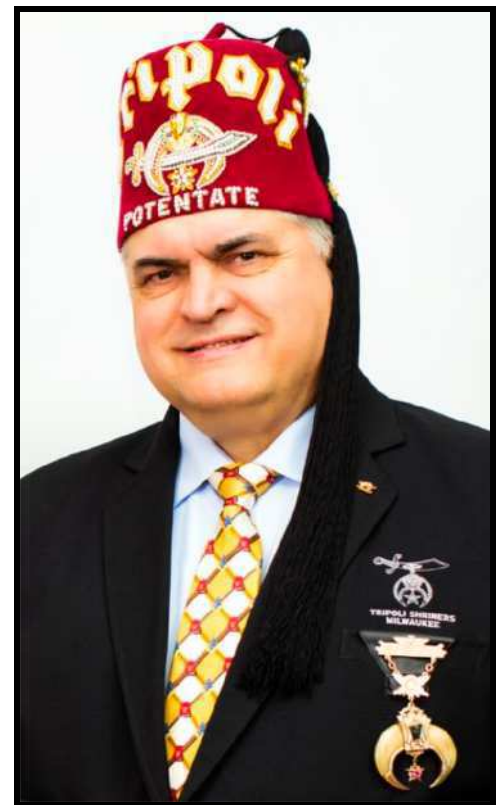
Speaking of the Daughters of the Nile, they are selling Chicken Pot Pies, place your orders today, don't wait.



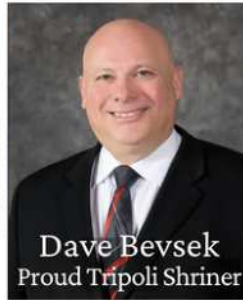

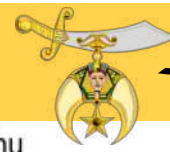
