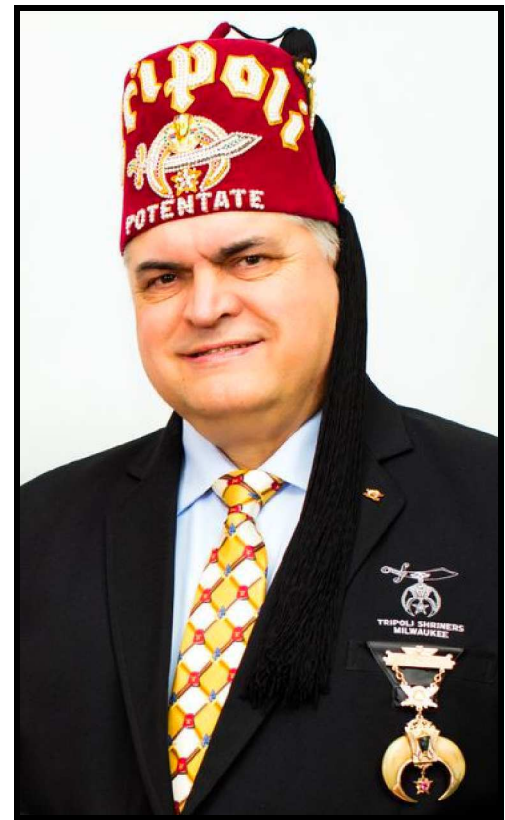

Of course, there is the Costume Party on Saturday, October 28th, time for some fun. See you at the Stated Meeting!

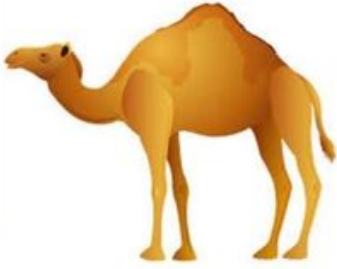

Divan Day at Shriners Childrens Chicago



Divan Day at Shriners Childrens Chicago

Shriners Children's administration and physician leadership opened the doors for the first time since the pandemic, to welcome Shriners who volunteer on the leadership committees of supporting temples (called the Divan), and their ladies. The early August event was called "Divan Day 2023. Moving past a pandemic. Looking to the future."

Among the speakers were Doctors Gupta, Morris and Mukherjee, who updated Shriners on the capabilities and amazing care in orthopedic, spine surgery, and supporting specialities, also plastic surgery, and pediatric rehabilitation. Nobles (as the Shriners are called) also received tours with hospital staff providing updates around the building, and a mini annual report of facts and figures about the hospital.

Carol from suburban Chicago was interviewed at Divan Day about her mother Roberta's experience as a hospital patient dealing with the effects of polio. Roberta, whose picture was displayed onstage, received care in the late 1920's/early 1930's.

Carol said her mother rarely spoke about her time at Shriners but Roberta did talk about being only one of two Shriners Chicago patients who spoke with President Roosevelt live on the radio, at a national benefit to raise money for polio research which became The March of Dimes. Roberta walked with a limp her entire life but went on to work, marry and have a family.

HALLIE GIVES BACK



Hallie was born with unilateral complete cleft lip and palate, in which a baby's lip does not form properly.

Hallie and her family say the care at Shriners Children's Chicago surpassed their expectations. After her first surgery, Hallie received an American Girl doll. This is just one of the many toys Hallie would receive after a visit or surgery.

After a couple of procedures Hallie asked her parents where the toys came from. Her parents, Travis and Katie, said, "Well people donate them."

Hallie decided she wanted to pay it forward and give back to the place that has given so much to her. Hallie is one of many patients who has decided to donate toys and other items for future patients at the Chicago hospital.

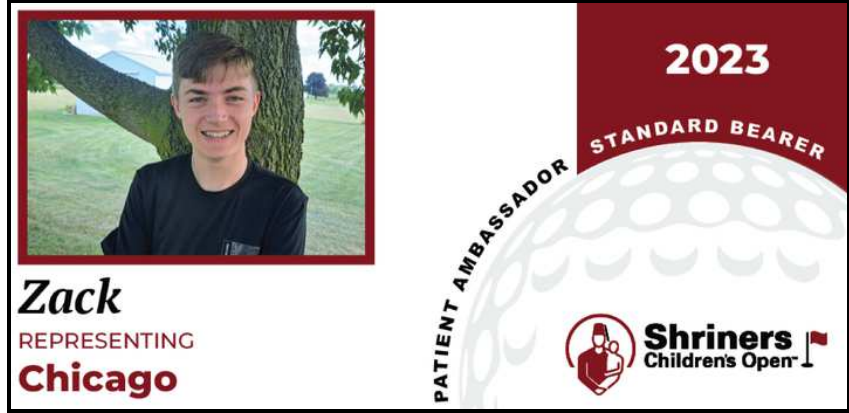

These two patient ambassadors, from Chicago and Twin Cities, are representing the pediatric care network at the tournament, where they will serve Standard Bearers throughout the weekend, carrying the scores of

professional golfers as they compete in the tournament. It is a rare “inside the ropes” opportunity at a PGA TOUR event, as well as the chance to share how Shriners Children’s has helped transform her life.

Zack, 16, is a high school junior hailing from northern Indiana. Growing up in Amish country, Zack attended a middle school where students learned solely using paper before transitioning to a high school utilizing laptops and other technology. As a high school student, Zack enjoys hanging out with his friends and serves as manager of his school’s baseball team. He has three older siblings and a younger brother.

Zack has been a patient of Shriners Children’s Chicago for eight years alongside his younger brother, with both receiving care for Charcot-Marie-Tooth disease. The condition affects the nerves that can control muscle movement, leading to numbness, muscle weakness, and, in Zack’s case, scoliosis. Zack received tendon transfers and reconstruction on both feet, and recently underwent



a spinal fusion surgery to address the curvature in his spine. He credits his outstanding nurses and surgical team for going above and beyond to help him progress toward a bright future.

Annabelle, nicknamed “Annie,” is a high school freshman from Fargo, North Dakota. She is active in school theater, sings in the choir and plays viola in the orchestra. Annie, 14, also enjoys reading, listening to music and spending time with her friends and family. Annie lives with her parents Troy and Liz, her sister Brooklyn, plus two golden retrievers and a tortoise.

Annie was born with severe clubfoot on her right side, together with hip dysplasia and fibular hemimelia, a condition where one is born without a functioning fibula, on the left side. It hindered development of her left foot, leading to an amputation when she was 11 months. Later, she was diagnosed with scoliosis as well. Annie has undergone 12 surgeries and has outgrown 14 prosthetic legs and numerous orthotic devices,



casts and braces. With back braces worn most of the day and night, and intense physical therapy, the curve in Annie’s spine has been decreased from 24 degrees to 10 degrees.

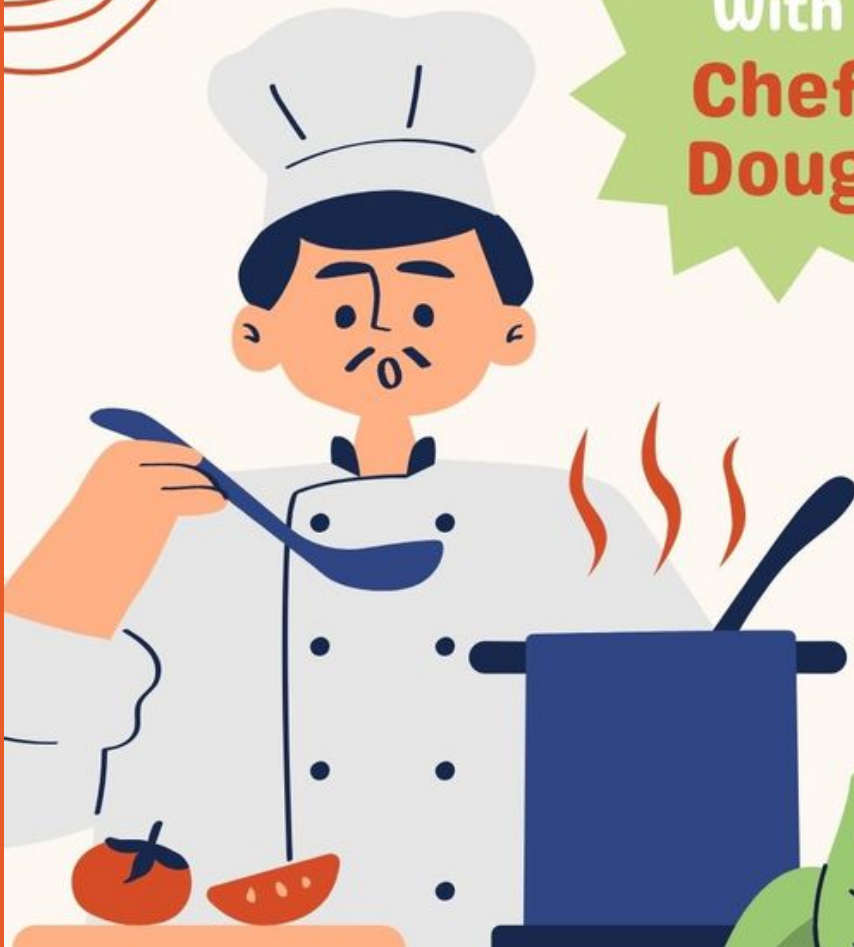

Changing the Game: Adaptive Sports



Adaptive sports, modified to fit the needs of the athlete, allow individuals to continue to do what they love.

Like many of our patients, Steven has grown up coming to Shriners Children's Philadelphia since the age of 5. He was diagnosed with transverse myelitis, a neurological disorder caused by inflammation to both sides of a section of the spinal cord. In Steven's situation, the inflammation occurred in his cervical spine.

Due to his condition, Steven has impaired strength and sensation throughout his arms and legs. This is defined as incomplete quadriplegia (tetraplegia).


After making the switch from playing wheelchair basketball three years ago, Steven began playing wheelchair rugby through the Magee Rehabilitation Program, and he has loved it ever since.





Juan Diego, 18, was burned in an electrical accident when he was 13, leaving his hands seriously disfigured. He spent more than a month in the hospital in Honduras. When he returned home, he was completely dependent on others for even the most basic tasks. He could not take care of himself, go to school, or draw or play music, two of his passions.

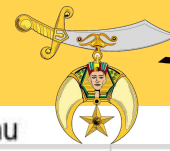

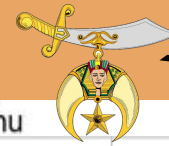

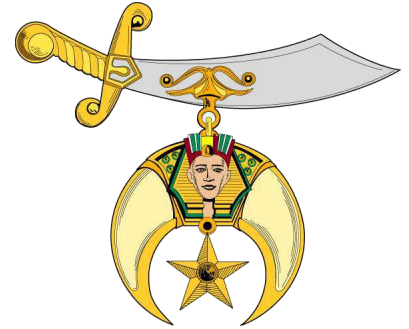
