





Autumn is officially here. On the 23rd of October Tripoli and the Knights of Columbus will be holding the annual All Faiths night, reservations for this are due in by October 16th. It would be great if we could move this event from the Melham Parlor to Humphrey Hall. Let's make that happen. October is also time for two holidays for our Jewish brothers. Rosh Hashanah, which means the head of the year, starts by sundown on Wednesday, October 2nd and ends after nightfall on Friday, October 4th. It is the traditional anniversary of the creation of the world and the creation of Adam and Eve. who are known as the biblical first man and woman. Rosh Hashanah is also a judgement day, when Jews believe that their god considers peoples deeds from the previous year, decides what the next tear will be like for them. Yom Kippur the day of atonement begins before sundown on October 12th and ends after nightfall on October13th. This is the holiest day of the Jewish year. 





### Stated Meeting & Election of 2025 Officers Wednesday, December 11, 2024

### 325.11 Election Regulations.

- (a) **Electioneering.** A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a résumé consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.
- (b) Expenditures Prohibited. The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.
- (c) Violation. For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.
  - (d) Notice. At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.

Please be sure to have your current dues card (2024) for the December meeting as only current, up to date members may vote. Your cards will be scanned to verify your status when you enter the Shrine Center. You may pay your dues that evening.

### ATTENTION: CLUB and UNIT LEADERS

Shriners International has outlined specific obligations for club and unit leaders in General Order #1, which ensures proper governance and record-keeping within the organization.

Elections for club and unit officers must be held on or before October 31st each year.

By November 30th. the club or unit secretary must submit to the Temple Recorder the details of the elected officers for the upcoming Shrine year. This includes verifying and providing the names, addresses, phone numbers, email addresses, and other relevant information.

By December 31st, clubs and units must submit the membership list for the upcoming year. This also includes verified contact information.

This structured approach ensures that the leadership and membership records are up-to-date and that Tripoli Shriners maintains a smooth and efficient operational flow.
