
Our next meeting will be in September as we go dark during the summer parade season. See you at the parades.














Our Chicago Motion Analysis Center team was at the Gait and Clinical Movement Society meeting in Columbus Ohio. Our team presented research on how 3D gait analysis can help improve surgery outcomes for kids with cerebral palsy and foot deformities.




