














Know Your Floble - Robert Haggarty

My Dad joined Pike Masonic Lodge when I was 9 years old. I couldn't wait to become a member of **DeMolay.** I petitioned for DeMolay membership six days after my 13th birthday. DeMolay was life changing for me, sending me to leadership school and being a member of the first three years of the Masonic Show Choir in Wisconsin. I was elected Master Councilor when I was just 14 years old. The Pike Chapter was very active, and it was an incredible learning experience. I am humbled to have received the Chevalier Award and the Active Legion of Honor from what I feel is the greatest young men's organization in America.

I joined Pike Masonic Lodge in 1990 where my dad was first line signer and Past Grand Master Bruce Christiansen were my two sponsors.

I joined Masonry because I wanted to lead my life like so many of the men that I had met while in DeMolay. Men like my dad (Bob Haggarty JR), Bruce Christiansen, Bill Day, Bob Moore, Darrell Aderman, Jay Rosell, Vince Shuler and so many others I was and am truly honored to have been mentored by.

I became a member of Tripoli Shrine in 1998 when I was an officer in Rose Croix in the Valley of Milwaukee. It was an incredible experience. I still think back to that day: about the fun, about the brotherhood. I am currently an elected member of Divan, holding the Office of Oriental Guide. While I enjoy all aspects of the office, I believe that I enjoy planning for the future the most. Learning what has worked and what has not worked. Learning about Tripoli's past and hopefully being part of the growth of its future.

Both Kristine and I grew up in Kenosha, Wisconsin, attending local schools. We met when we were 15 and 16 years old, when my voice teacher wanted me to mentor her. She and I became best friends: however, we never dated. I would take her to dances and actually took her to her first nice restaurant (she ordered steak and potatoes while I ordered Lobster Thermidor). She would walk to school on her hands (a block short of two miles), even crossing the street that way. I would see her and pick her up in my 1972 Camaro. Upon graduation

Tremper High School, Kristine joined the United States Air Force, while I attended and graduated from College, Carthage staying in Kenosha. I had not wanted to stay here; instead, I wanted to go to the University of Notre Dame, and although I was accepted, I couldn't figure out a way to pay for it. Carthage College offered me two scholarships: 1) to be part of their debate team; 2) to sing opera.

Kristine went on to live in Texas, New Mexico and Pennsylvania prior to me bringing her back to Wisconsin.

She is an elite athlete who was invited to the 1980 Olympic trials in gymnastics and was also the first woman to qualify for the United States Air Force competition team.

I would see Kristine often when she came back to Kenosha to visit family. Again, we never dated, just good friends. As we look back, God kept bumping us into each other, each time harder than the last.

In 1994, I was a bank officer while Kristine was finishing Nursing School in Pennsylvania. During that time, the bank was robbed, and I was the



officer on duty. The bank robbers left a bomb upon their exit, and to try to ensure my employees' and customers' safety, I had them go into the vault and lock the door. I stayed out with the bomb, standing right next to it while I followed up with the police. I made myself and God two promises that day: 1) I was going to change careers; 2) I was going to marry Kristine.

Once the authorities arrived, a member of the Bomb Squad asked me if I was religious. I asked why and he responded that all the parts of the bomb had touched, but for some unknown reason, it just hadn't detonated. I then watched as they blew up the bomb in the field close to the bank. I woke Kristine up at 2 AM after returning from work that day. I told her about what happened and also told her she needed to come home on a break from school that was a month away. She said she couldn't because it was expensive, and I let her know I would pay for it. Once home, we took the train to Chicago to see Phantom of the Opera

and then had dinner at Trader Vic's.

She questioned why I asked her to come home, and I just blurted out that I loved her, and that I always loved her. She started to cry, and I thought I had really blown it. Instead, she said she had loved me since she was 15 but never thought I was interested.

We never really dated; instead, we got married. A client of mine (judge) married us on his 50th Wedding Anniversary and his wife was our witness.

We have five kids. Robert, Clayton, Claire, Christian, and Mary-Kate live all over the United States.

I am actively involved in:

Divan, Motor Corp – most fun on four wheels. Actually, the most fun I have ever had in Masonry, Animals, Banquet and Catering Committee – Bar, and multiple Shrine Clubs.

Tripoli excites me because of the opportunity to make a difference. I want to leave Tripoli better than I found it back in 1998. While membership at 1990 level may not be possible, we can make changes to meet the challenges of the future.

I know that our community is better with masonry and Shriners and I want to be part of the leadership team that makes that happen.

I also promised my wife, Kristine, that if elected, Potentate will be my last major Fraternal office. I have been Master Councilor, Worshipful Master three times, Most Wise Master and Chairman of Trustees for Scottish Rite, and the Potentate for Tripoli Shrine. I am so incredibly honored to have been given this extraordinary trust from my brothers. After that time, with the exception of helping with the hospitals, and driving a scarab, I will spend my time with my bride traveling and experiencing life all over the world.

Looking into the future, I see Tripoli continuing to be forced to change. Tripoli, as well as all of Shrinedom, will continue to evolve in how we accept and welcome spouses. We must continue to realize that men committed to their families will encourage Masonry to foster a more family-friendly atmosphere at many of our gatherings. Look at most of the great leaders in our Country and our world.



Those Leaders have the support and the leadership of their spouses. We need men who have relationships with spouses like that. I am so blessed to write this upon having just this type of experience. We need to mentor men, recognizing that the most important decision we make in our lives is our choice of a life partner, which allows all of us to benefit.

Joining Tripoli, Motor Corp, Animals and finally being asked to be a member of Divan has made Masonry exciting. That is what Shrinedom is all about: having fun and in so helping kids and serving society.







Shriners Children's Opening First-of-Its-Kind Research Institute in Atlanta



Idea born of inquiry

The proposal for a Shriners Children's Research Institute grew from a collaboration that started in 2019 between the Georgia Institute of Technology Pediatric Innovation Network and the Shriners Children's Research department, headquartered in Tampa, Florida. Leanne West, Chief Engineer of Pediatric Technology at Georgia Tech, worked with Marc Lalande, Ph.D., our vice president of research programs, to partner engineers with surgeons and physicians with the goal of making innovations to improve the lives of pediatric patients. Over 25 joint research projects have produced innovative devices, such as robotic exoskeletons to assist patients with cerebral palsy and flexible, wearable sensors to monitor sleep problems in cleft lip and palate patients. Using artificial intelligence has yielded new knowledge from the extensive Shriners Children's clinical database to pinpoint genetic markers in adolescent idiopathic scoliosis and other conditions.

Once told he may never play again, Shriners Children's orthopedic sports medicine and rehabilitation therapy kept Jayden on the team.

Jayden suffered a complete fracture of his femur in football camp before high school. He's on track to play college football beginning later this year. The second-oldest of four siblings, Jayden, 18, of Chicago, was invited to a selective football camp in Tennessee at the end of his eighth-grade year, back in 2021. It was there that he was hit by two big defenders as his quarterback simultaneously rolled onto him. The impact caused his femur to snap, and Jayden's family wasn't sure where his football career would go from there. After emergency surgery in Tennessee, Jayden returned home.

After Jacky did her research online about orthopedic surgery, her son started receiving care at Shriners Children's Chicago. From the moment she called, Jacky said she knew the nonprofit healthcare system was the right place. "Football is Jayden's life ... I'm not just going to go to any doctor, I'm going to find the best doctor for him because this is something that he loves. This is his future," Jacky said.


