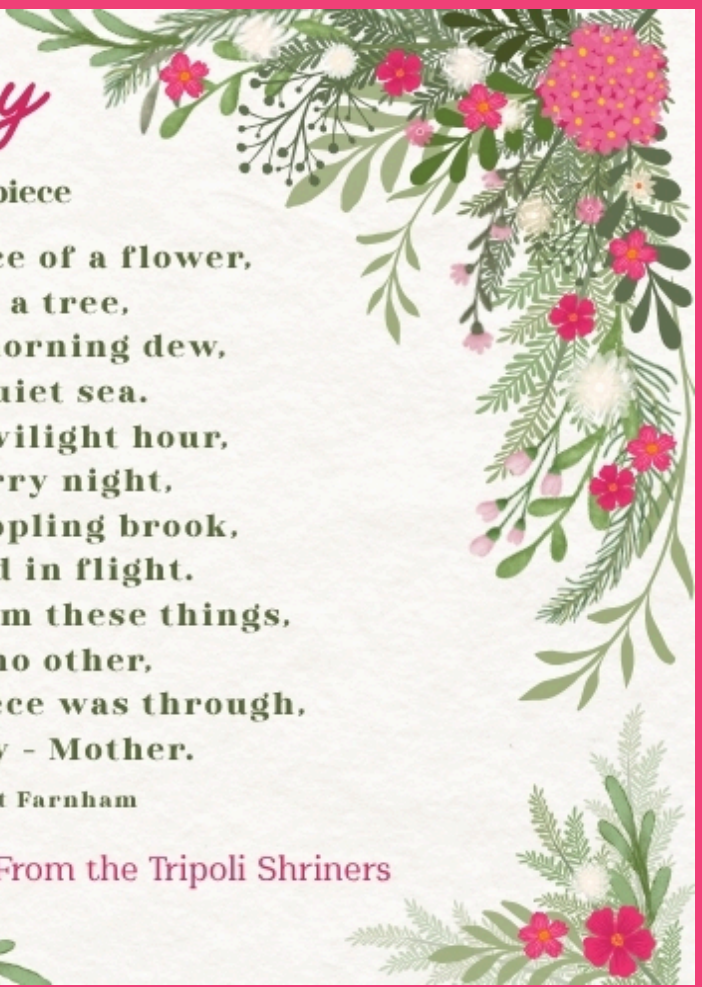

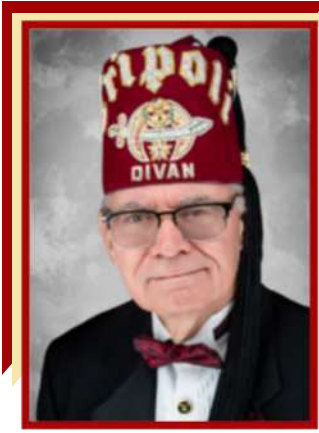

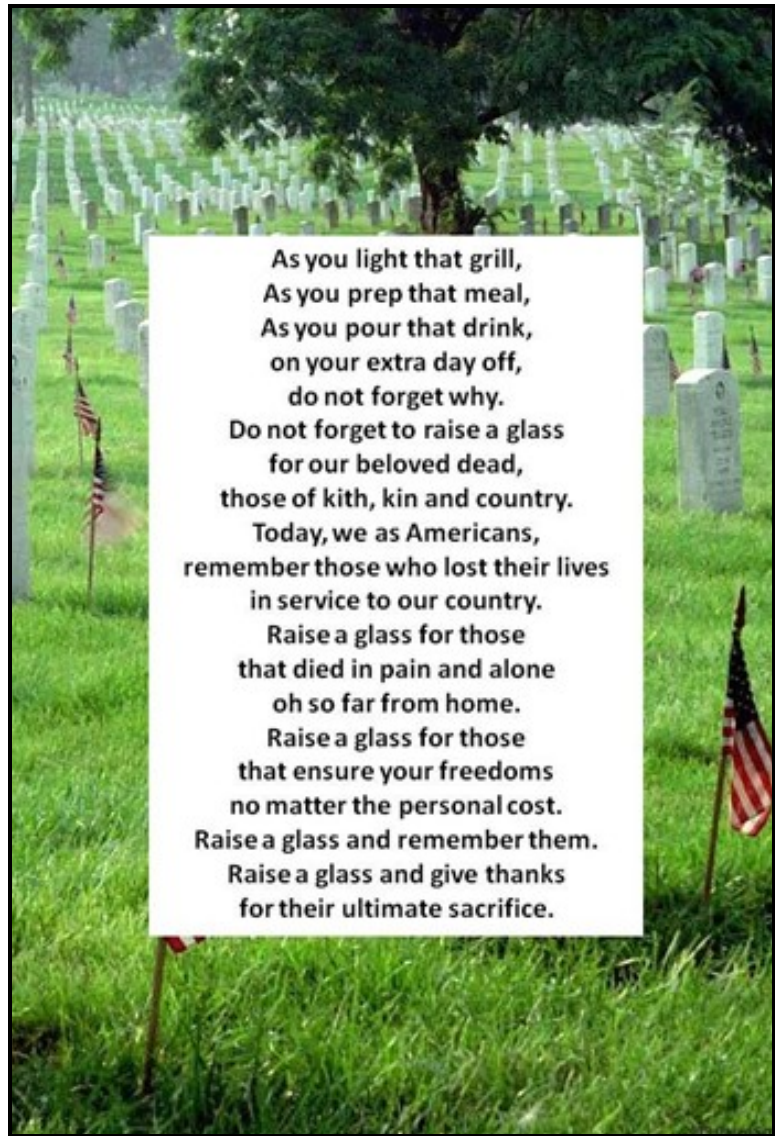
Chaplain's Corner Robert Tjewski

Membership Facts

- There are now 202 Shrine Temples world-wide, one more than a year ago.
- As of December 31, 2025, there were 160,042 Shriner Members, 6,858 fewer than a year ago.
- The largest temple is Oasis in Charlotte, North Carolina, with 3,283 members - down by 182 members.
- The state with the largest Shrine population is Pennsylvania, with 10,124 - down by 694 members from a year ago.
- Wisconsin has 1,690 Shriners, down 89 from a year ago.

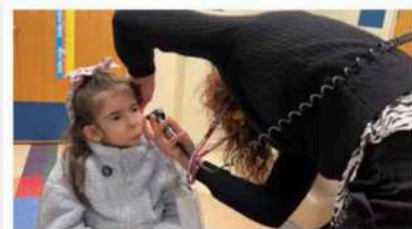

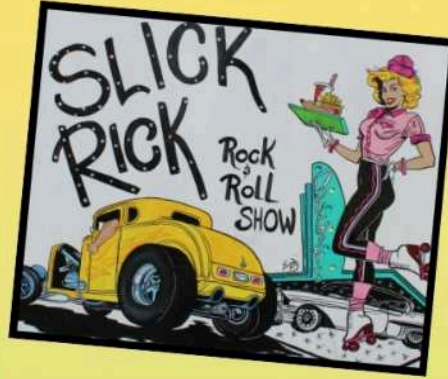

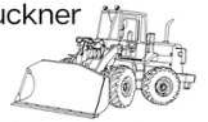
